

## Hut Access and Booking Policy

### The Cabin

The committee have decided to offer members **free** access to The Cabin, although you will have to cover your own fuel and electricity costs.

### Hut Access

In future, access to The Cabin will be via a numerical keypad lock on the main door. The Custodian will provide members wishing to use The Cabin with the door code, which will be changed frequently.

Members are welcome to use the hut at short notice. To gain access please check:

- The Cabin is not booked already, availability can be viewed at: [http://www.edinburghjmcs.org.uk/huts/booking\\_calendar.html](http://www.edinburghjmcs.org.uk/huts/booking_calendar.html) , and
- confirm that the hut is available with the Custodian **before use, and at a reasonable hour**. The current custodian can be contacted most evenings before 9pm via mobile: 07810 865754, home: 01383 732232 or email: [alib1@talktalk.net](mailto:alib1@talktalk.net) .

**You must actually speak to the Custodian, or receive an email reply, before using the hut.** This is to ensure that you have the current code and to avoid double bookings. **DO NOT** just send the Custodian an email and set off without getting a reply!

We assume that members will act with appropriate consideration to the Club, each other and other hut users. To repeat, members **must** confirm availability with the Custodian before trying to use the hut. Please **do not** disclose the door code to anyone outwith your party.

We hope these steps will make The Cabin an easier, cheaper and more flexible location for club members to enjoy! Please treat both The Cabin and the Custodian with sensible consideration.

### The Smiddy

The committee have also decided to offer members free access to The Smiddy, although again you will have to cover your own fuel and electricity costs. However, there will be no change to the entry system and members must continue get a key from the Custodian.
